Safeguarding for Community Organisations

This course is aimed at those who work in the community, and who need to understand the legislation around the safeguarding of adults and/or children. The course can be adapted to focus on adults or children.

The tutor was trained by LSIS (Learning and Skills Improvement Service) as a facilitator of Safeguarding Training, and is the Designated Safeguarding Officer for DCFL, which is a local charity providing training in the Dacorum area.

At the end of the course, learners will be able to:

- Give a definition of Safeguarding
- State the relevant legislation concerning Safeguarding
- Define 'regulated activity', under Safeguarding legislation
- Explain what we are safeguarding people from
- List different types of abuse, and how they might recognise them
- State the 5 'R's in relation to Safeguarding
- Say who their Designated Safeguarding Officer is, or where they would refer issues to
- Explain what they would do if they came across an issue
